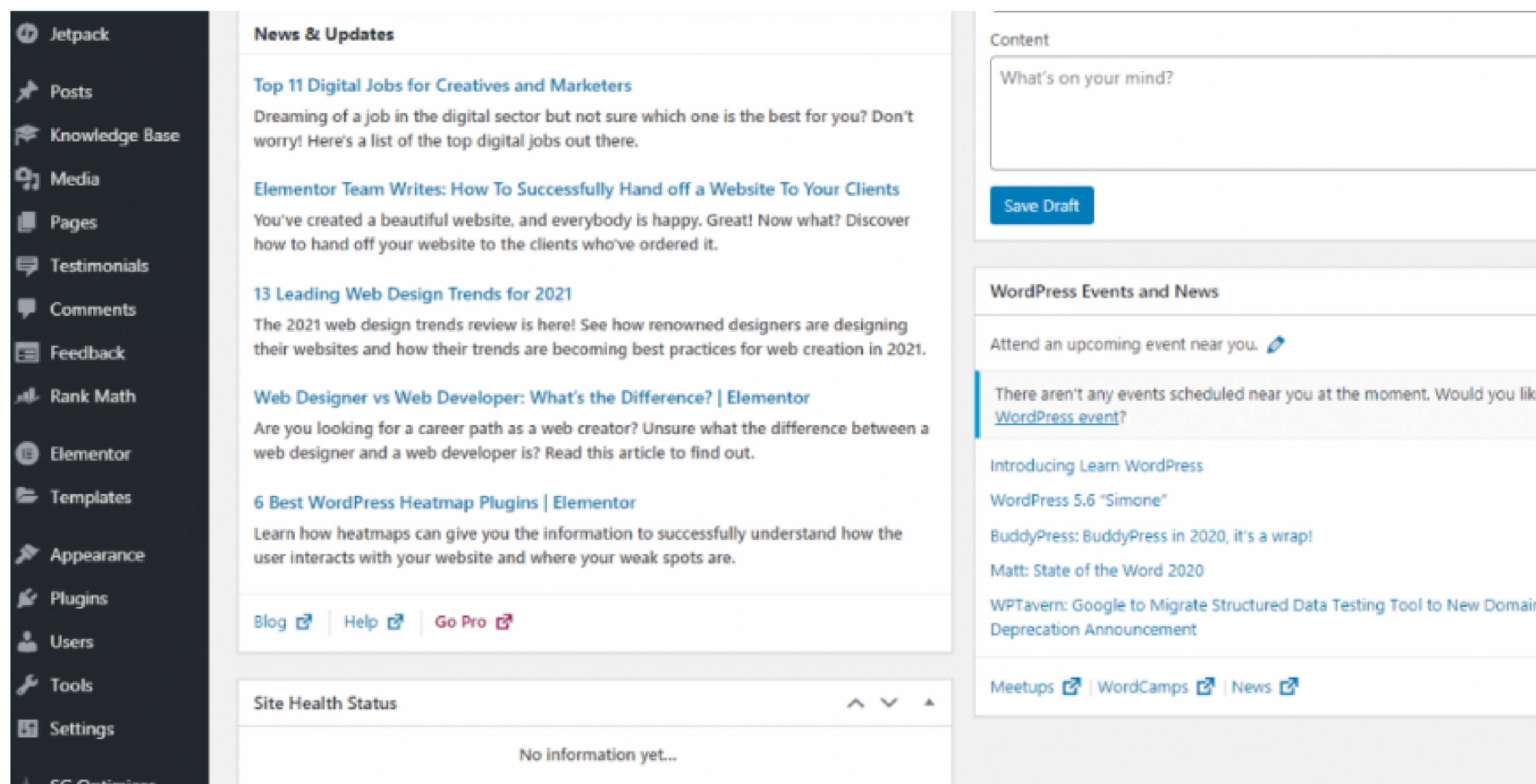


How to login to your WordPress admin panel from your Cpanel

Here in this article, I am going to walk you through on how to login to your WordPress admin panel through your CPanel.

On a typical **WordPress** site, all you need to do is add **/wp-admin/** to the end of **your** site's URL. and these URL will take you to **your login page** where you can enter your **username and password**.

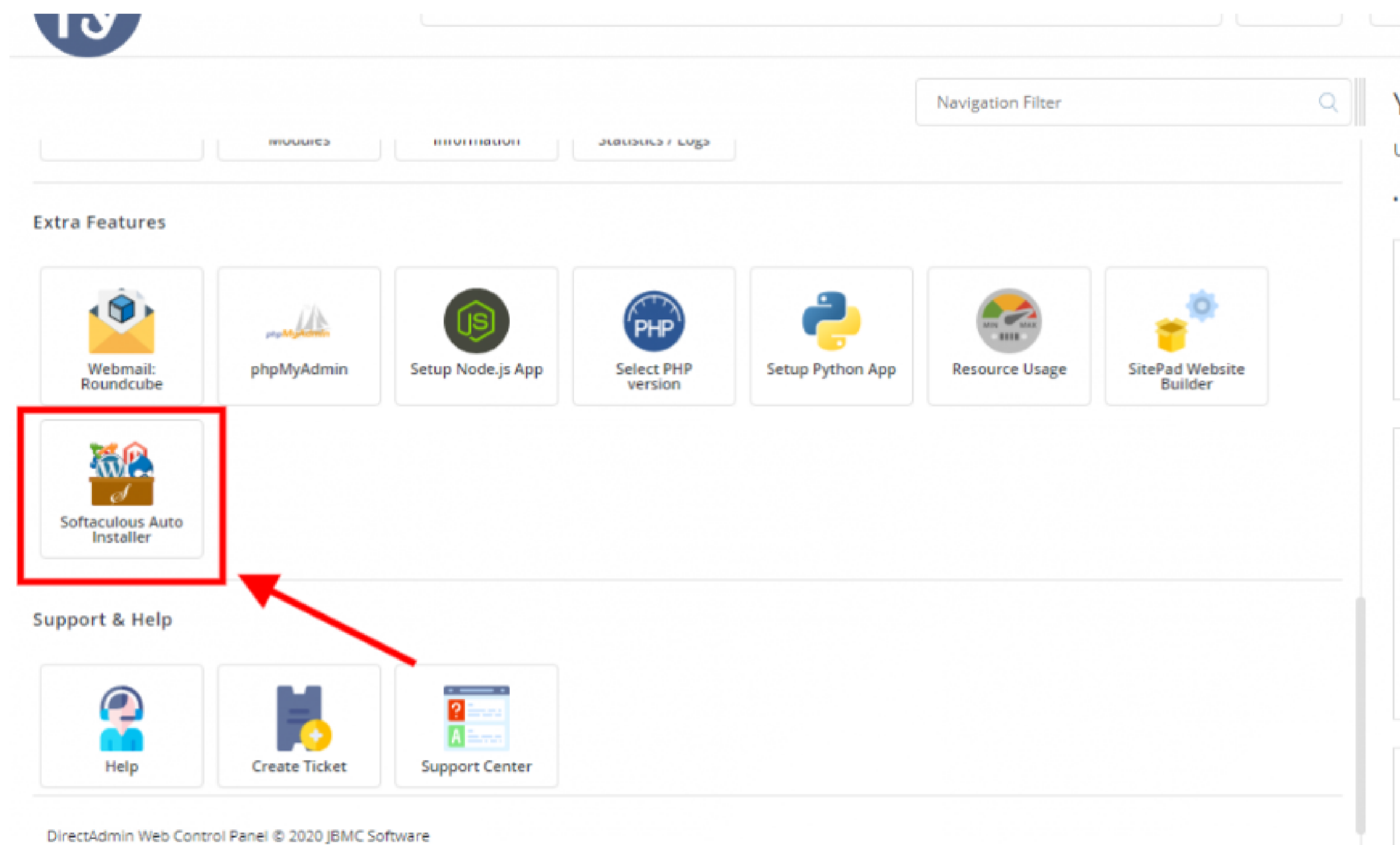
Sometimes you might forget your WordPress admin panel login details and you aren't able to login using the WordPress admin login URL to your admin backend.

Don't worry anymore, you are going to learn how to access your WordPress backend right from your Cpanel without having to use your **username or password**

Let get started on how to login to your WordPress admin panel

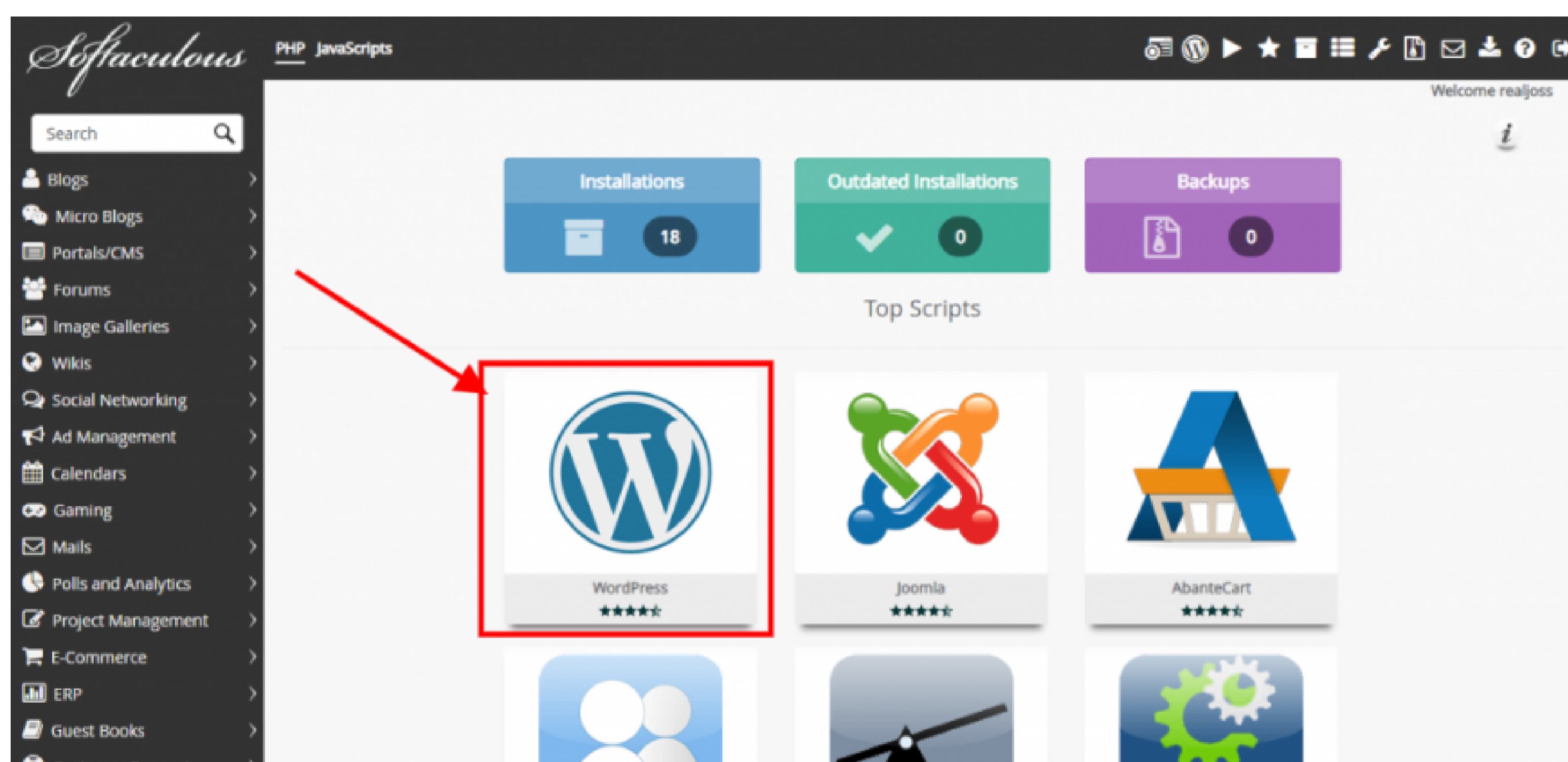
First, Login to your **Control Panel (Cpanel)** and go to **Softaculous Auto Installer**

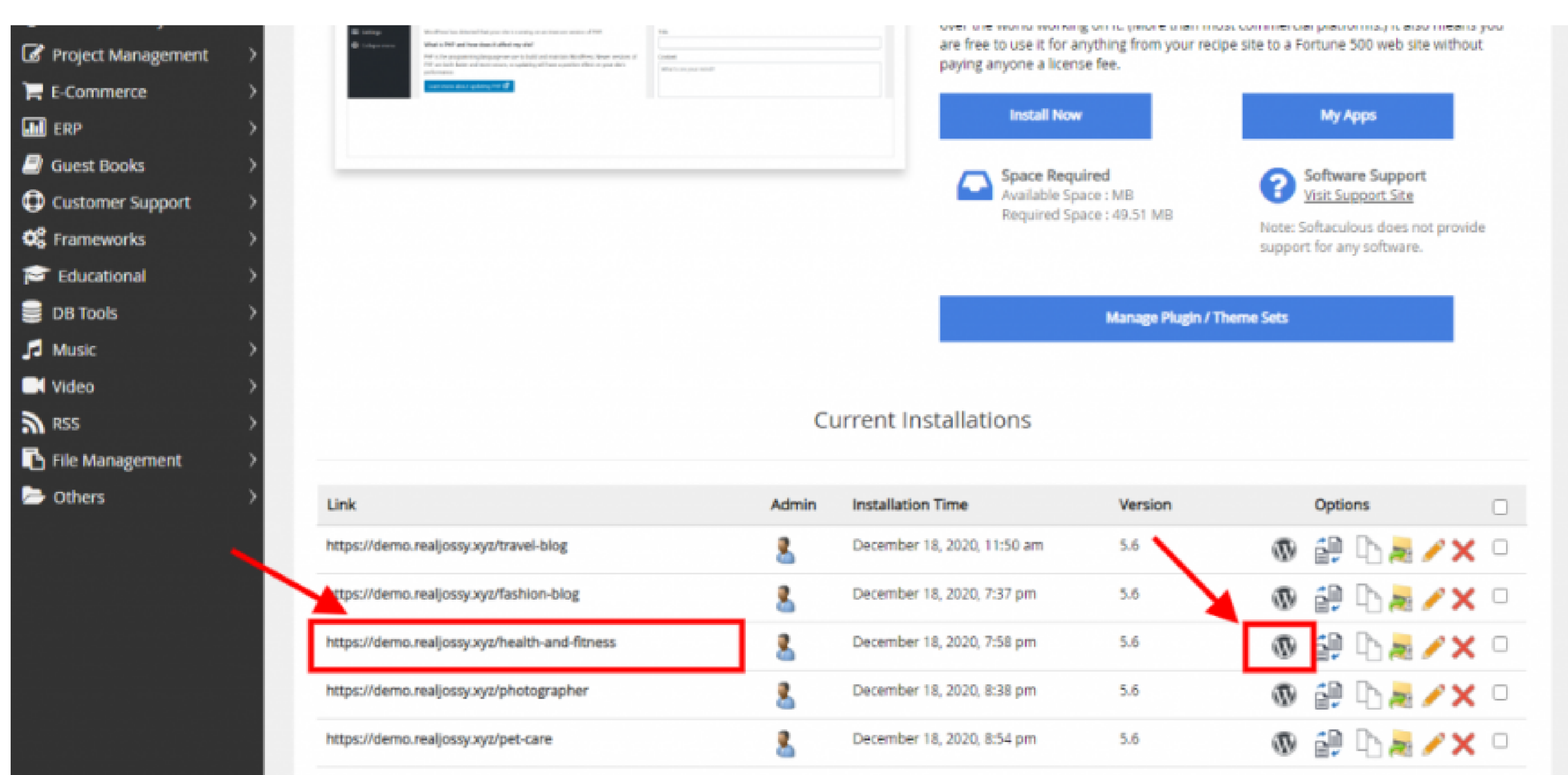
Open the App and look out for the **WordPress Logo**

Open the App, On the next page, **scroll down** to the list of installed WordPress website

From the image above, you can see all my **installed WordPress Websites...** If your own case, you have installed just one WordPress website, then you will see just a single list of your installed WordPress website.

For my case I have lots of WordPress websites..

What you have to do here is locate the website you want to log into and click the WordPress logo at your right-hand side as shown on the image above.

You will be taken to the next page where you will see the **login button**

Click on the **login Button** to access your **WordPress backend** without having to use your **username and password**
